HEALTH FAIR SNAPSHOT

Last year over 10,000 free screenings were provided. With over 25 different types of screenings, Our goal this year is to provide early detection for diabetes, hypertension, obesity, and education and more.

Triglycerides – 16% borderline and 23% at-risk of total screened

Total cholesterol –18% borderline and 4% at risk of total screened

Glucose – 32% borderline and 10% at –risk of total screened

Lead Poisoning – 10% tested positive for elevated lead levels

BMI – 78% of total screened were overweight or obese
